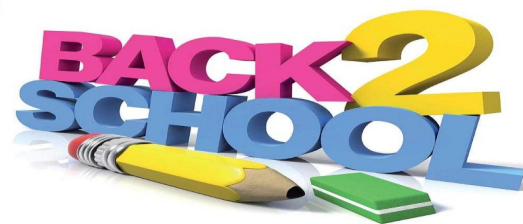
NEW NEIGHBORS??!

DINNER CLUB

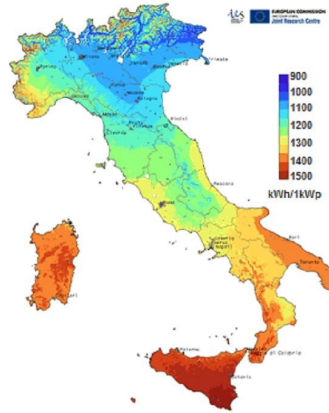
